

**LAUREL WATERSHED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 1**

SETTING THE 2018 ASSESSMENT RATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the LAUREL Watershed Improvement District (“LAUREL WID”) has approved its budget for the succeeding year, attached to this resolution as Exhibit A, and

WHEREAS, the budget consists of work items that will benefit the owners of assessed lands within the LAUREL WID, and

WHEREAS, the LAUREL WID must make assessments in proportion to the benefits accruing to the lands assessed, and

WHEREAS, the LAUREL WID must conduct an assessment equalization process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of the LAUREL WID establish a regular assessment for 2018 in the amount of \$ 6.00 per acre for all parcels exceeding 4.5 acres subject to the assessment within the boundaries of the District, and that said assessment shall be imposed and collected pursuant to the system of assessment established by Whatcom County and Chapter 87.03 RCW.
